

IDSA Begins COVID-19 Press Briefings

More than 50 print and broadcast reporters from national, local and trade outlets, including USA Today, CNN, The Boston Globe and The Philadelphia Inquirer participated in the first in a series of IDSA-sponsored COVID-19 virtual press briefings Friday, April 3. IDSA CEO Chris Busky moderated as IDSA President Tom File, M.D., FIDSA and HIVMA Vice Chair Rochelle Walensky, M.D., FIDSA, answered questions from journalists and discussed the role of the ID physician in COVID-19 response and the importance of social distancing. IDSA's Call to Invoke the Defense Production Act

Within the past week, IDSA has twice <u>called on President Trump</u> to invoke the <u>Defense Production Act</u>, to speed the production of needed medical supplies. <u>A</u> <u>decision announced by the Trump Administration on Thursday</u> marks another step toward getting medical professionals urgently needed supplies, but a strong national and long-term strategy utilizing all available resources and mechanisms is still urgently needed to ensure availability of medical supplies.
